# What attitudes in Christians break down trust in faith and the Church? Why do they cause a lack of trust?

Like any organization filled with human beings, ambition, cynicism, and weak character lurk in the Body of Christ. Chalk these faults up to the frailties of human nature or the effects of original sin. Baptism does not take away the temptation to dwell in the self; ordained ministry does not guarantee altruistic leadership. Christians, like anyone else, can fall into sins of selfishness.

In this Sunday's Gospel, Jesus addressed ambition, judgement, and weak character with images common to his time. In doing so, he touched upon the discourse of the last two weeks: the beatitudes-woes and love of enemy.
